There will be a show of attending smiths' works, so please bring a sample of your work, whether beginning or advanced. If enough people bring slides we will include a slide show of attending smiths' work. If you have a portable blacksmithing set-up please bring it so that we can share our techniques and ideas at the forge.

This conference is a direct result of the forge-in held at Big Anvil Forge in Bethel, Missouri, one year ago. The purpose of a state branch of ABANA is to help smiths improve their work, to provide a vehicle to lift the status of smithing as an art form, to provide a variety of demonstrators, both local, nationwide and worldwide, and to get traveling shows of ironwork into the Missouri area. If you are interested in forged metalwork, please help us with this. There will be monthly meetings held in all areas of the state with your help, so that it will be possible for you to obtain benefits from ABANA without traveling clear across the country. If you cannot attend both days of the conference, please attend one day, or send in your dues for the Missouri Area Branch of ABANA. There will be a monthly newsletter with tips, information, events, and the location of the monthly meeting.
